The Music Department in the Hudson City Schools has participated in the Ohio Music Educator Association's Solo and Ensemble adjudicated event for many years. This is not a required commitment, but is an outstanding way for students to improve their musicianship. Students who take private lessons may take a solo to contest and are encouraged to do so.

Preparation for the solo is to be done with the private instructor. It is important that the music chosen is within the technical ability level of the player so that you may fully experience the musical aspects of the music in performance. It is recommended that freshmen and sophomores play a class B or C solo or ensemble, and juniors and seniors play a class A or B solo or ensemble. **No freshman will be permitted to play a class A solo or ensemble without prior approval from Mr. Moore. Soloists must have a piano accompanist unless the solo or ensemble is published as an unaccompanied solo**

All solos and ensembles must be chosen from the OMEA approved solo and ensemble list. To access the list and find the song code for your entry, go to OMEA-ohio.org. At the top of the page scroll over the word "events" scroll down to "adjudicated events" and click on "Solo & Ensemble." Scroll down the page and click on Vocal Solo or Ensemble required list to view the song code along with the correct book that a student must have in order to receive a ranking. Please make sure your chosen composition is on this list before you turn in your entry. Please check the OMEA website under adjudicated events for scale requirements in each classification.

Fees for solo and ensemble are \$21.00 for solos and \$26.00 for ensembles. Ensemble fees should be divided up and paid for by all members of the ensemble. A check made out in that amount to **Hudson Music Association** must accompany the registration slip below.

Parents and friends are welcome to come and hear the performances, but there is no photography, video or audio recording allowed at this event. **Audio or video recording will result in the disqualification of the performer.** If you have questions about Solo and Ensemble contest please contact Mrs. Reed (reedk@hudson.k12.oh.us)

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- **Attached to the form 1 (one)** check for each event made payable to **Hudson Music Association**. Please *print the name of the soloist* on the memo line. Solos are \$21 and ensembles are \$26
 - Soloists must provide the name of your accompanist for scheduling purposes
- All contestants will need to provide the judge with the **original** score or part **with each measure numbers**
 - Please make sure the accurate song code is written on the entry form
